As part of Monmouth Comprehensive School's Summer Learning activities (19th – 21st July) Year 10 will be participating in a number of activities both in and out of school. These activities are designed to offer different learning experiences to those available within their usual timetable. As a school we are covering the cost of the transport required for these activities and therefore there will be no cost to students.

Community Well Being Project; Tuesday 19th and Wednesday 20th July.

Each form has been designated a local primary school to work with and students have been tasked with designing, organising and delivering a Health and Wellbeing Day for Year 5 and 6 students. The activities will be chosen and led by Year 10 students and will include competitive and non-competitive sports, diet and nutrition, mindfulness, reading for pleasure and developing confidence and self-esteem. It is a component of the Community Challenge of the Skills Challenge Certificate and is worth 15% of the overall qualification. Students should wear clothing appropriate to the volunteering work they will be undertaking and will also need to bring a packed lunch for the Tuesday. Transport will be provided for schools outside the Monmouth area.

Walk to 'The Biblins'; Thursday 21st July.

Students will walk to the 'Biblins' along the old railway track that follows the River Wye from Monmouth to Symonds Yat. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and appropriate clothing and footwear, suitable for all weathers.

Unless advised by the activity leader, for off site visits students will leave on arranged transport after registration and return in time for home to school transport as normal. Students do not need to wear school uniform during Summer Learning. Please ensure that students wear clothing suitable for the activity in which they are taking part, including appropriate footwear.

In accordance with the School's Health & Safety procedure failure to give consent will result in your child not being able to take part in these activities. Please complete by Friday 8th July.
