As part of Monmouth Comprehensive School's Summer Learning activities, Year 10 will be participating in a number of activities both in and out of school. These activities are designed to offer different learning experiences to those available within their usual timetable. The Monmouth Comprehensive School Friends Association are kindly supporting some of the costs of the events but we ask for a contribution of £8 from each child.

By law these are activities for which we are unable to make a charge. However, we are asking for a contribution of £8 towards the overall costs of the events.
