Dear Parent,

The Mathematics Faculty are delighted to offer the opportunity for students currently in Year 10 to visit Paris next year to enhance their appreciation of mathematics in the real world. The trip will depart on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> February and return on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2027, during half term. Students will discover the beauty of mathematics through a wide range of enrichment activities. They will visit Disneyland Paris and have a day to explore the city of Paris, viewing the architecture and engineering of the city's key landmarks including the Arc de Triomphe, The Louvre and a visit to the Eiffel Tower. This trip will have many cross-curricular links with various other subjects.

Based on 90 students the cost of the visit is £665.00. The cost includes executive coach travel to Paris, 3 night's accommodation at a Disney partner hotel on a half board basis, entrance to both Disneyland parks, the Eiffel Tower, and the Louvre. Insurance and a personalised hoodie will also be included. It does not however, include pocket money, lunches or meals en route. **ALL students will require their own passport with at least 3 months left after the date of return.**

Due to the nature of the trip, only students with a very good track record of behaviour will be permitted to attend. We reserve the right to refuse a place to any student with a poor record of co-operation and following instructions.

#### Securing a place:

To secure a space for your child, you will need to request a trip place via parent pay before midday on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March. Up to 90 students will be allocated a space with priority given to those students that have demonstrated the highest standards in meeting expectations. Should the demand exceed availability, we will place remaining students on a reserve list.

You will be informed of the outcome via email by Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March, please ensure you check your junk email. **Students that have successfully gained a place on the trip will have until Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March to pay their deposit (£60).** Deposits will not be required until your space has been confirmed. Any deposits not paid by the deadline will result in the child losing their space.

#### Payment Schedule:

If a student is allocated a space trip and then removed at a later date due to poor behaviour, their refund will be in line with the travel agent's cancellation policy. If you join the trip at a later stage, your initial payment will be required to be in line with the payment schedule above.
