Study Leave for Year 13

Until the official school leaving date of Friday 24th May, Year 13 students should attend all timetabled lessons alongside any examinations that they might be sitting. If a student has an exam prior to this date, they can take a half day study leave on the day before the exam, which they will need to arrange with Mrs Guest in the Sixth Form Office.

BTEC / Vocational courses which have no exams

Students will attend lessons after 24th May until they are 'signed off' by the course leader when work is completed for all modules.

Students must wear correct school uniform for all examinations. Students must assemble at 8.50am outside the examination room in preparation for a 9.00am start. For afternoon examinations, students should ensure that they have sufficient time to have lunch and prepare themselves thoroughly to be seated in the examination room by 12.50pm.
